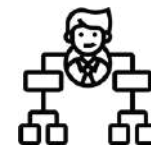

PRESSING ISSUE #1

Personal and Spiritual Health and Professional Development

Personal

Protect your eyes and ears
(Jeremiah 5:21)

1. Look to God for help in peace as a model for others.
2. Be still. Listen for God's voice in confidence and prayer.

Professional

See and hear "to steer the ship"
(1 Cor. 12:28)

1. Diligence (Rom. 12:6-8) in the details, vital but often mundane.
2. Discernment (James 3:13-18) evident in good works.

PRESSING ISSUE #2

Increasing Effectiveness and Efficiency

Be like Jethro was to Moses (Exodus 18)

- Came to Moses, listened, made an offering, and praised God.
- Watched Moses and spoke up, "What you are doing is not good. You and these people who come to you will only wear yourselves out. The work is too heavy for you; you cannot handle it alone."
- Advice: "Select capable people to make the load lighter" (delegate).
- Approach, listen, worship, watch, speak, and share the burden.

PRESSING ISSUE #3

Managing Expectations and Dealing with Challenging Personalities

Promote Faithful Activities

1. Take narrow way (Mt. 7:13-23)
2. Thank God for fruits (Acts 2)
3. Endure suffering (1 Pet 2:21)
4. Rely on grace (2 Cor. 12:9)
5. Pray continuously (1 Th 5:17)

Stay Focused on Christ

1. Guard your heart (Prov. 4:23)
2. Stay the course (2 Tim. 3:12-17)
3. Do everything in love (1 Cor. 16:14)
4. Serve humbly (Luke 22:24-27)
5. Give God the glory (Is 42:12)

BIBLICALLY FAITHFUL (STEWARDS)

If we take a "biblically faithful" approach to these pressing issues we will experience many benefits. Church and ministry administrators will...

1. Have clear vision with discernment
2. Help God's people work together to accomplish more
3. Teach others to delegate in order to share the burden of work
4. Exhibit a keen ability to listen carefully and speak with clarity
5. Advance faithful activities to position churches for fruitfulness
6. Keep everyone's focus on Christ undistracted by personalities

GLOBALLY CONSISTENT (STANDARDS)

If we take a "globally consistent" approach to these pressing issues we will experience many benefits. Church and ministry administrators will...

1. Use templates to work smarter and more efficiently
2. Implement processes that increase effectiveness
3. Ensure legal compliance – "Do what is right before man"
4. Reflect a higher standard – "Do what is right before God"
5. Help the church stay focused on its mission
6. Implement best practices to engage God's people to serve

LOCALLY CONTEXTUALIZED (SUSTAINABILITY)

If we take a "locally contextualized" approach to these pressing issues we will experience many benefits. Church and ministry administrators will...

1. Help keep God's house in order (administration and governance)
2. Abide by local laws and regulatory requirements
3. Engage local experts for service to churches
4. Manage details with diligence and discernment
5. Know pitfalls to avoid while maintaining vision and momentum
6. Remain in Christ as a model for endurance and perseverance

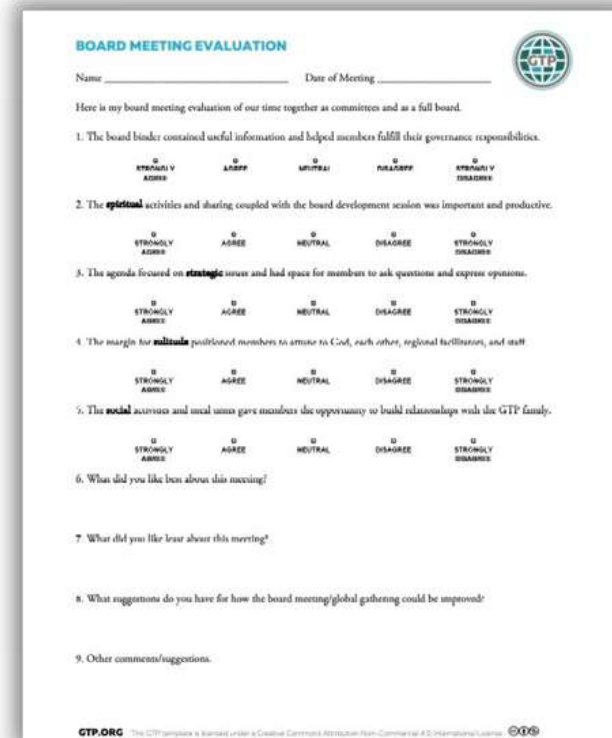

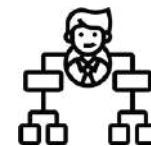
